

## Local Rules

*These Local Rules are applicable in addition to the „Hard Card“ of Swiss Golf. For this championship they replace all Local Rules previously published by the hosting golf club.*

### 1 Boundaries

- (a) Boundaries are defined by white stakes or white lines or by fences with white posts (holes 5...8, 12, 13 & 15). Where a fence defines the boundary, the course side edge of the fence posts defines the boundary of the course.
- (b) A ball coming to rest on or beyond the road between the 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> hole is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.

### 2 Penalty Areas (2<sup>nd</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> Hole)

Where an artificial wall surrounds the edge of a pond on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, & 18<sup>th</sup> hole (between red stakes with black stripes), the penalty area is defined by the water-side edge of the wall. A ball is in the penalty area when it is beyond these walls.

### 3 Dropping Zones (2<sup>nd</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> Hole)

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball last crossed the edge of a red penalty area adjacent to the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> putting green between the red stakes with black stripes, the player has these relief options, each for **one penalty stroke**: The player may take relief under (i) R17.1, or (ii) as an extra option, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone next to the putting green of the related hole. The dropping zone is a relief area under R14.3.

### 4 Nursery Green

The nursery green between the 3<sup>rd</sup> teeing area and the 4<sup>th</sup> putting green is a wrong green.

### 5 No Play Zones (NPZ)

Areas identified by stakes with green tops and staked trees are **no play zones**. **Entering an NPZ is forbidden!**

- (a) If a player's ball lies in a penalty area marked as NPZ, for **one penalty stroke** the player **must** take relief under R17.1d.
- (b) If a player's ball lies in GUR marked as NPZ, the player **must** take relief under R16.1b.
- (c) If a player's ball lies outside an area marked as NPZ, but the NPZ interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **must** take relief under R16.1f(2).

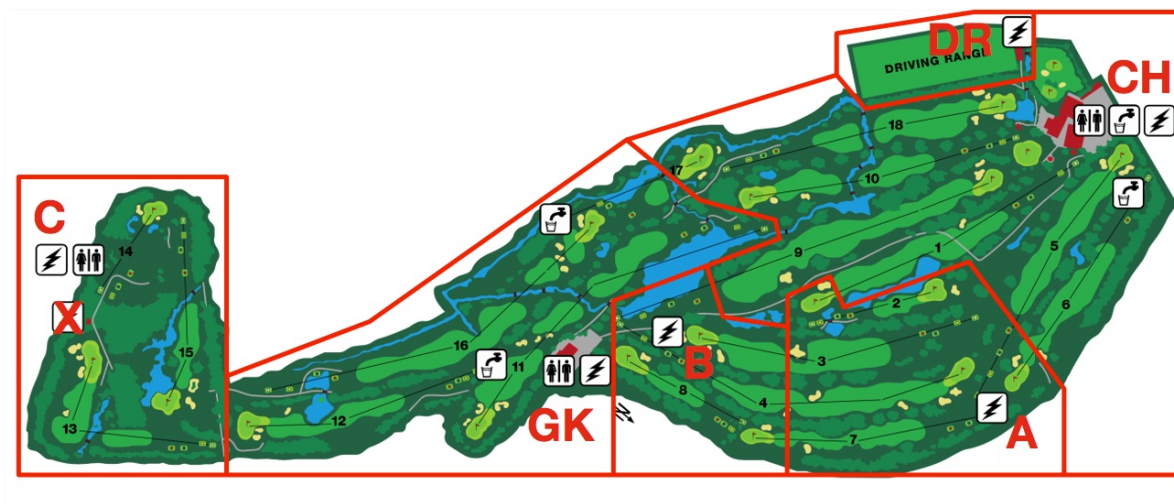
### 6 Abnormal Course Conditions & Integral Objects

- (a) Benches, bins & ball washers close together are to be treated as one single immovable obstruction;
- (b) Stones with tee signs attached and the wooden sculpture behind the 6<sup>th</sup> putting green are immovable obstructions;
- (c) Trees fenced in to protect them from damage by beavers are GUR;
- (d) Boulders creating the artificial walls surrounding the ponds on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> hole as well as those surrounding teeing areas are integral objects (**no free relief** under R16.1b).

## Course Evacuation in Case of Lightning

When play is suspended due to lightning (**one prolonged note** of a siren), players must take shelter according to the following plan. **Golfbags and trolleys are to be left outside the protection hut!**
